SUBJECT: Precinct #4 and #9 Polling Place Relocation

### Background

In a letter dated November 3, 2010, Ms. Deborah Peltier, Business Manager for St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Church (280 E. Square Lake Rd.), requested that the City of Troy no longer house voting precincts #4 and #9 at that location. Since that time, the City Clerk's Office has been in contact with First United Methodist Church (6363 Livernois). First United Methodist Church has volunteered use of their facilities to house voting precincts #4 and #9 during future elections.

On May 26, 2011, the Election Commission voted unanimously to approve the relocation of the two precincts to First United Methodist Church beginning with the August 2, 2011, Special Election.

### Recommendation

City Management recommends approval of relocating voting precincts #4 and #9 to First United Methodist church beginning with the August 2, 2011, Special Election.

### Fund Availability

Funds for the printing and mailing of new voter ID cards is available in the City Clerk's Elections Budget.
