

LOCAL AREA UNEMPLOYMENT STATISTICS UPDATE

NOVEMBER 2011

On **January 3**, the BLS released updated Local Area Unemployment Statistics for November 2011 and **OAKLAND COUNTY's jobless rate fell from 9.4% to 8.1%**. The decrease of 1.3% in the jobless rate was the largest single month decline since the same time period in 2010. **OAKLAND COUNTY'S** 12-month unemployment rate dropped from 10.4% to 10.2% for the period from November 2010 to October 2011 compared to a drop of 10.7% to 10.5% for the State of Michigan over the same periods.

The jobless rates for each of the region's counties are provided **ABOVE**. Overall, the region's labor force declined by 25,156 participants while the number of employed residents increased by 6,457 from October to November.

To the **LEFT** are the current jobless rates for each community in **OAKLAND COUNTY** with a minimum population of 25,000 residents. In October 2011, the jobless rate in each community was significantly lower than the same period of the previous year.
