1. **EI Patio IV, LLC** requests to Transfer Ownership of escrowed 2011 Class C licensed business, located at 645 Opdyke, Auburn Hills, MI 48326, Oakland County, from Fiero Lanes Inc. to EI Patio IV LLC; transfer location (governmental unit) (MCL 436.1531(1) to 2891 E. Present to answer questions from the Committee was Maria De La Paz, an owner of the business.

Ms. De La Paz informed the Committee that this restaurant opened approximately two months ago. They have made minor interior modifications which have not yet received final approval from the Building Department. She and her husband own two other EI Patio Restaurants; one is located in Waterford and the other in Farmington Hills. The Farmington Hills location has a liquor license. All employees will be trained for alcohol service.

Officer Feld informed the Committee that the petitioner had one police contact in 2011 in Novi but no charges were filed. There have been no liquor violations at the Farmington Hills restaurant.
