SUBJECT: **AGENDA ITEM** – Standard Purchasing Resolution 6: Grant Approval And Authorization to Expend City Funds – Radio Equipment

Recommendation

City management recommends that the Troy City Council approve the use of funds received from a U. S. Department of Justice, Save our School Grant and authorizes the purchase of radio equipment under existing Oakland County contract, at an estimated cost of \$40,000.

Background

The City of Troy has received a U. S. Department of Justice, Save our School Grant for \$40,000. The grant will be used for the purchase of mobile radios to operate with the new Oakland County 800 MHz digital trunked radio system. The equipment purchased is covered under the existing Oakland County contract with M/A-Com Inc. the system provider.

This is a 50% federally funded project with a 50% local match.

Budget

Funds for this equipment are available through the Police Department Capital Fund, Account # 401.325.7980.055. The resolution amends the Police Departments budget to receive the grant funding and allows it to be expended on the designated items.
