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NOTICE OF HEARING  
FOR THE ELECTRIC CUSTOMERS OF  
THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY  
CASE NO. U-14702

- The Detroit Edison Company may implement maximum power supply cost recovery factors of 4.99 mills per kilowatt-hour (kWh) in its residential customers bills, and 8.29 mills per kWh in its commercial and industrial customers bills, each subject to increase based upon a contingency matrix, for the 12-month period beginning January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006, if the Michigan Public Service Commission approves its request.

**PARTICIPATION:** Any interested person may attend and participate. The hearing site is accessible, including handicapped parking. The Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) will hold a public hearing to consider the September 30, 2005 application of The Detroit Edison Company (Detroit Edison)

for approval of a power supply cost recovery (PSCR) plan, 5-year forecast and monthly maximum PSCR factors, each subject to increase based upon a contingency matrix utilizing projected power supply cost increases associated with Electric Choice participation rates and the Company's projected power supply expenses, of (a) 4.99 mills per kWh on the residential customers' bills whose rates were subject to caps during 2005, and (b) 8.29 mills per kWh on the commercial and industrial customers whose rates were not capped in 2005, including an amount reflecting the projected 2005 PSCR Plan year under-collection, for the 12 month period January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006.

**The Commission has selected this case for participation in its Paperless Electronic Filings Program. Any person wishing to make a statement of position without becoming a party to the case may participate by filing an appearance. To file an appearance, the individual must attend the hearing and advise the presiding administrative law judge of his/her wish to make a statement of position.
