**Recommendation**

Staff recommends the Acting City Manager approve the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board recommendation to adopt the Fee Waiver Policy for Active Military Personnel on Leave.

**Background**

At the May 18, 2006 meeting, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board recommended that City Council adopt the Fee Waiver Policy for active Military Personnel. The City Manager has been authorized to establish fees for services in the Parks and Recreation division therefore the request for approval is being forwarded to the Acting City Manager.

## **Fee Waiver Policy for Military Personnel on Leave**

Eligibility: Troy residents who are active members of the U.S. Armed Forces, Reserve, or National Guard. "Active Service" shall mean full-time or part-time status in one of the branches of the U.S. military forces. Inactive service status does not qualify.

Active members of the Armed Services, Reserve or National Guard who have returned to Troy for no longer than 30 days for either leave or furlough are eligible for fee waivers of the following:

Community Center Fitness Areas  
Troy Family Aquatic Center  
Sylvan Glen and Sanctuary Lake Golf Courses (no more than eight free rounds)

Proof required:

- 1) U.S. Armed Forces Identification Card showing active status  
AND
- 2) Authorized leave or furlough orders
