The Clackamas County Sheriff's Office Domestic Violence Enhanced Response Team would like to thank you and your agency for your support and participation in the 3rd Annual National Family Violence Apprehension Detail. We would especially like to acknowledge your efforts in locally coordinating your agency within this national effort. This year was a success as we continued to substantially increase warrant attempts and services. Nationally agencies reported the following statistics for the detail:

- 5857 Attempts of Warrant Services
- 1159 Warrants Served
- 1465 Law Enforcement Personnel Participated
 - 60 Probation and Parole Personnel Participated
 - 20 District Attorney Victim/Witness Advocates Participated
 - 4 Shelter Worker Participated
 - 8 City /District Attorneys Participated
- 63 Other Members from Agencies and Local Communities Participated (U.S. Marshals, Correction Officers, Reserve Officers, etc.)

Most importantly, agencies across the United States sent the message that offenders will be held accountable for their actions. We understand that this voluntary effort is hard work and can be a burden on resources, but because of your dedication, the number of attempts increased 66% and the number of arrests increased 79% from last year. We look forward to your participation next year, as we anticipate continuing our increasing efforts.
