SUBJECT: Agenda Item - Request to Waive Parking Restrictions

The Congregation Shir Tikvah, 3900 Northfield Parkway, requests that the no parking restrictions on the east side of Northfield Parkway from the entrance to the synagogue parking lot to the entrance to Boulan Park be waived on the following dates and times:

- Friday, September 22, 2006, 7:00 pm – 11:00 pm
- Saturday, September 23, 2006, 9:00 am – 5:00 pm
- Sunday, October 1, 2006, 7:00 pm – 11:00 pm
- Monday, October 2, 2006, 9:00 am – 9:00 pm

This request is made to accommodate parking for attendees of the High Holidays observances on those dates. Shir Tikvah has an agreement to utilize the parking lot of the Stonehaven Church (Wattles Road e/o Northfield Parkway) and desires to eliminate the need for attendees to park in adjacent sub-divisions. Waiving the no parking restrictions will allow service attendees to park on the unpaved shoulder of the roadway. Synagogue officials indicate they will ensure those parking there do not impede traffic.

The police and fire departments process this request each year and are not opposed to it.
