Subject: Standard Purchasing Resolution 4: Award – Macomb County Cooperative Purchasing Agreement – Fleet Vehicles

**History**

The seven (7) vehicles being purchased are replacement vehicles for the Police Department. The seven (7) obsolete vehicles will be removed from service and sold at auction with estimated proceeds of \$30,000.00. This purchase replaces existing vehicles and does not increase the size of the existing Department of Public Works motor pool fleet.

**Purchasing**

Sterling Heights Dodge is the low total bidder in the Macomb County Cooperative Bid. The Macomb County Contract ID number is 01-13. The contract pricing is valid thru the 2014 model year for Chrysler, Dodge and Jeep vehicles.

**Financial**

Funds are available in the Public Works Fleet Division capital account.
