A public hearing has been scheduled for City Council to review the following liquor license violation:

Licensee Name: Yara, Inc., d/b/a Lebanese Grill
Address: 1600 Rochester Road, Troy, Michigan 48083
License No: 77842-2012 SS
Violation: SALE TO MINOR (Compliance Test) on March 20, 2013

Under Michigan law, one single violation of state or local liquor laws COULD serve as a basis for City Council to object to the otherwise automatic renewal of an on- premises liquor license. An on-premises license allows alcohol to be served on site, such as in a restaurant, and this is distinguished from an off-premises liquor license, where alcohol is purchased at retail and taken to another location for consumption.

By scheduling liquor hearings for those licensees that have violations during the preceding year, City Council has the ability to inquire about proactive measures that the licensee has taken or is willing to take to avoid future liquor license violations. If City Council finds that there was a violation during the past year, and Council is also concerned that the liquor licensee is likely to have continued liquor violations, then state law provides a process to revoke the on-premises liquor license. Prior to taking any adverse action, however, City Council must hold a public hearing and allow the licensee to come forward with any proactive measures that it has taken to guard against future liquor license violations. The public hearing also allows any neighbors of the licensee to voice their concerns to the City Council. If Council determines that an on-premises liquor license should be terminated for health, safety and welfare concerns, then City Council must pass a resolution and forward it to the Michigan Liquor Control on or before March 30. If there are no objections to a licensee's continued operation, then the on-premises liquor license will automatically renew for the upcoming year, starting May 1.

A copy of the reports documenting the alleged liquor law violations is attached to this memo, as well as the liquor licensee's history. Upon information and belief, the licensee is not contesting the liquor law violation, and an adversarial public hearing will not be required. However, City Council will need to officially open the public hearing and make a record of the violation. City Council will also need to offer the licensee an opportunity to comment, and also to entertain the comments of members of the public. At the conclusion of the comments, City Council may wish to require some proactive measures to guard against future violations. Based on the liquor licensee's past history, City Administration has prepared a resolution for City Council consideration that acknowledges the violation and requires the licensee's serving employees to obtain server training within 90 days.

On 3/20/2013, the Directed Patrol Unit (DPU) conducted LCC checks with minor decoy :

identification was confiscated and held for safe keeping by the Troy Police department.

At Approximately 1820 hrs, Decoy entered the LEBANESE GRILL Restaurant located at 1600 Rochester Rd. in Troy. Upon entering the restaurant, took a seat at a table. The waitress, who was later identified as REMONDA ELYAS, approached to take his order. ordered a "Short's Brew Bellaire Brown beer". ELYAS did not ask for any identification and returned shortly with the beer.

FISHER notified PO JULIAN of the violation and waited for officers to arrive.

PO STOPCZYNSKI and I, PO JULIAN entered the restaurant and made contact with REMONDA ELYAS and the owner ABE CHARAF. Both subjects were advised of the sale to our minor decoy and of the Michigan Liquor Control Commission violation. ELYAS was advised of and issued the civil infraction of "furnishing/sale to a person under 21/fail to inquire of age" on ticket# 741830.

While speaking with ELYAS, PO STOPCZYNSKI inquired if she had undergone TIPS (Training for Intervention ProcedureS), to which she replied that she had not. Officers advised owner CHARAF that all employees that serve alcohol should receive TIPS training.

MLCC violation form was completed and submitted.

Officers retained a sales receipt of \$4.24 for the beer and placed it on evidence.

NEGOTIATED SETTLEMENT

Abbas Charaf, President of the above Licensed Corporation, appeared before this Commissioner represented by Attorney Jonathan Martone. Mr. Martone, with Susan Moody, Assistant Attorney General representing all law enforcement in this matter, proposed the following Negotiated Settlement for the Commissioner to consider for this case pursuant to Section 903 of the Michigan Liquor Control Code and Rule 436.1909 of the Michigan Liquor Control Commission (Commission):

PROPOSED NEGOTIATED SETTLEMENT

- (1) The Licensee will fully acknowledge the one charge, cited above;
- (2) The Commissioner will enter the Violation Report of this case and attachments thereto into the record as substantive evidence without objection. The Commissioner further will take notice of the prior record of this Licensee, since securing Commission licensure at the above-named location under the current ownership;

(3) The Licensee will agree to the sanction of a fine of \$650 for the single charge, cited above, as penalty in this matter; and

(4) Both parties hereto will agree that there shall be no appeals on this matter to the Appeal Board of the Commission or any court of law.

ORDER

In determining whether to approve the Negotiated Settlement as proposed above, the Commissioner considered support of the aforementioned settlement by Officer Kate Raczka on behalf of the Troy Police Department.

In determining whether to approve the Negotiated Settlement as proposed above, the Commissioner considered the Licensee's total record, which shows two (2) previous violations, one similar to the instant case, since securing Commission licensure on November 1, 2000, at the above-named location under the current ownership.

In consideration of the aforementioned circumstances and statements, the Commissioner hereby accepts the terms and conditions of the proposed Negotiated Settlement and Orders as follow:

The Commissioner accepts the Licensee's plea of acknowledgment to the single charge, cited above.

The Commissioner hereby accepts the Violation Report of this case and attachments thereto as substantive evidence without objection; further, the Commissioner hereby accepts a true copy of this Licensee's record since securing Commission licensure at the above-named location under the current ownership.

Based upon the aforementioned plea by the Licensee and a review of the Violation Report and attachments thereto, the Commissioner finds that the Licensee in this case violated


Section 801(2) of the Michigan Liquor Control Code, MCL 436.1801(2), as cited in the one charge of the Complaint in this matter.

As penalty, the Commissioner Orders a fine of \$650. In addition, the Commissioner Orders that a suspension of thirty-three (33) continuous days be imposed if the total fine of \$650 is not paid within forty-five (45) days of the date this Order is mailed. This suspension, if served, shall be served consecutively and not concurrently with any other suspensions Ordered by the Commission for this Licensee.

In addition, the Commissioner Orders the Licensee to pay \$17.30 for witness fees for this hearing.

The Licensee agrees this Negotiated Settlement was a full and final disposition of this matter before the Commission. The Licensee recognizes that, as to this Complaint, there is no further right of administrative or judicial appeal, to either the Commission or a court of law. The Licensee also agrees that the plea in this case was entered voluntarily and with the full understanding of all consequences. Furthermore, all parties agree that there are no promises, stipulations, understandings or agreements other than those stated above as part of the official record. This document represents the final agreed settlement.


