SUBJECT: Rifle Exchange

Background:

- Police Department's Tactical Support Team initiated research to replace its four sniper rifles, due to age (15 plus years) and unreliability.
- Two of the rifles (Heckler & Koch PSG-1) have some collector value, as they no longer are produced.
- Three licensed firearms dealers were contacted regarding the trade of the old rifles.....Title II Services, the company used in the last firearm trade, D and D Gunsmiths in Troy, and Williams Gun Sight Company of Davison; as well as Double Action shooting range in Madison Heights.
- Only one of the three dealers, Williams Gun Sight agreed to provide four new state of the art rifles in exchange for the old. The City will also receive the necessary scopes, mounts and cases for these new rifles.

Financial Considerations:

- There is no cost to the City of Troy.

Legal Considerations:

- Other vendors were contacted, but nobody was interested in a trade.
- City management has determined no advantage would result from a sealed bid process due to limited competition and the specialized nature of the weapons.

Policy Considerations:

- The exchange of surplus property for new equipment minimizes cost and increases government efficiency. (Goal I)
- New rifles will be reliable, and provide necessary equipment to the Tactical Support Team to protect the public (Goal VI)

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Specifications For:

Tactical Response Rifle Package

Action: Remington 700 Short Action

Blueprinted-The re-cutting of all critical surfaces, locking lugs, receiver lugs, threads and face of receiver and bolt face. Scope mount hole enlarged to 8-40 for greater strength.

Barrel: Hart stainless steel barrel in .308 win. Caliber with 1-12" twist to stabilize 168 grain match ammo. Barrel will also be contoured to the maximum heavy varmint contour with a 24" finish length. A Holland Recoil Lug is also fit at this time for greater stiffness and surface area.

Stock: H.S. Precision PST25 with both adjustable cheek piece and length of pull. This stock also features a vertical pistol grip and dual swivel studs in the forward position.

Trigger: Jewel Trigger set at 3# with standard safety position.

Trigger Guard: HS detachable stainless steel trigger guard and magazine box with one 4 round magazine and one 10 round magazine.

Scope Mounts: Warne Picatinny Tactical base with 20 M.O.A. forward angle for extended ranges. Each rifle is supplied with two Warne Maxima Tactical ring sets, which are available in 30mm as well as 1".

Scope: Leupold 4.5x14x50mm L R/T M1 with side focus, fine duplex, 30mm main tube and 1/4 m.o.a. click adjustment.

Finish: All metal parts are DuraKoted in matte black, which matches the black color of the stock. This finish is non-glare and offers corrosion protection.

Each rifle is delivered in a Dorskocil two rifle case with a cut-out for an extra ten round magazine and enough room for ammunition and bi-pod storage. Other cases are available at an additional charge, dependent on departmental regulation.

Each rifle is test fired with the ammunition intended for use. Test targets are supplied with each rifle. Expected accuracy is sub ½" center-to-center measurement at 100 yards.

Federal 168 grain Match ammunition is standard. Remington 168 grain has also shown good accuracy as well as Black Hills Ammunition.

Package price: \$3727.00 per rifle.
