The following items will be pulled from the agenda this evening:

I-4 Troy Family Daze

An agreement has been made between the Troy Daze Committee and the new owner of the property sold by Zion Christian Church authorizing the use of the property for the Troy Daze event this year (September, 2014).

A study session will be scheduled in October, 2014 (after the event this fall) to discuss options for future Troy Daze events.
