PARTICIPATION: Any interested person may attend and participate. The hearing site is accessible, including handicapped parking. The Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) will hold a public hearing to consider the February 9, 2007 application of Consumers Energy Company (Consumers) seeking approval to adjust its existing retail natural gas to provide additional revenue of not less than \$88.3 million annually above levels established in Case No. U-14547, and to produce a rate of return on common equity of not less than 11.25%. Consumers is also requesting that the Commission grant final rate relief that will be effective for the 2007-2008 heating season.

Any person wishing to intervene and become a party to the case shall electronically file a petition to intervene with this Commission by March 14, 2007. (Residential customers may file petitions to intervene using the traditional paper format.) The proof of service shall indicate service upon Consumers Energy's attorney, H. Richard Chambers, One Energy Plaza, Jackson, Michigan 49201.

Any person wishing to make a statement of position without becoming a party to the case, may participate by filing an appearance. To file an appearance, the individual must attend the hearing and advise the presiding administrative law judge of his or her wish to make a statement of position. All information submitted to the Commission in this matter will become public information: available on the Michigan Public Service Commission's Web site, and subject to disclosure.
