- City management and the Public Works Fleet Division recommend the purchase of (1) one 2007 Dodge Charger for Police department use to Golling Chrysler Jeep Inc. of Bloomfield Hills, MI through an approved Oakland County Cooperative Purchasing Agreement at an estimated total cost of \$22,252.00.
