SUBJECT: Request to Temporarily Waive Parking Restrictions

Background:

- Each year PMV Technologies, which is located at 1026 Maplelawn, hosts an open house that is heavily attended by their business associates and community members.
- This year's open house is scheduled for Thursday, June 21, between the hours of 3:30 PM and 9:30 PM.
- It is anticipated that approximately 200 guests will attend this year's event.
- PMV advises that on-site parking cannot accommodate all the anticipated guests.
- Both sides of Maplelawn are marked "No Parking".
- PMV requests that the parking restrictions on the non-hydrant side of Maplelawn be waived, during the specified open house hours, to allow for guests to park on the street should the parking lot become full.
- This request was granted last year without incident.

- City Ordinance prohibits parking on Maplelawn; therefore, City Council action is required to grant a variance.
