SUBJECT: 2007 Year-To-Date Calls for Police Service Report

Background:

- Each quarter the police department publishes a year-to-date report comparing the previous years calls for police service, criminal offenses, clearance rates, traffic crashes and citations issued, with the same time period of the current year.
- Attached is a spreadsheet comparing the January through March of 2007, time period to the same months of 2006.
- The report's format complies with the National Incident Based Reporting System. All offenses within an incident are reported.
- Group A Crime decreased 23.6% (222 incidents) from the 2006 level. Within the group, the following categories show significant variations from 2006:
 - Breaking and Entering: Down 21.3% (16 incidents)
 - Destruction/Damage to Property/Vandalism: Down 41.9% (39 incidents)
 - Motor Vehicle Theft: Down 40.0% (20 incidents)
 - Robbery: Down 75.0% (6 incidents)
 - Assault Offenses: Down 12.8% (21 incidents)
 - Embezzlement: Down 30.0% (9 incidents)
 - Counterfeiting/Forgery: Down 88.6% (31 incidents)
 - Larceny/Theft Offenses: Down 23.4% (90 incidents)
 - Drug Narcotics Offenses: Up 12.2% (6 incidents)
 - Fraud Offenses: Up 17.1% (6 incidents)
- Group B Crime decreased 26.7% (119 incidents). Significant variations from the 2006 levels occurred in the following:
 - Drunk Driving: Decreased 9.6% (10 incidents)
 - Disorderly Conduct: Decreased 28.9% (13 incidents)
 - Bad Checks: Increased 160.0% (8 incidents)
 - Liquor Law Violations: Increased 73.3% (11 incidents)
- Total incidents of crime (Group A & B combined) decreased by 24.6% (341 incidents).

- Clearance rates (the percentage of offenses for which a perpetrator has been prosecuted, or positively identified but not prosecuted) for Group A Crime increased from 34.7% in 2006 to 36.1%, and for Group B Crime from 62.0% to 84.9%. In total, during the first quarter of 2007 52.8% of all reported crime was cleared, as opposed to 43.5% for the same time period in 2006.
- Arrests (including the issuance of a summons) for Group A crime violations decreased by 2.2% (7 arrests), and increased 7.4% (21 arrests) for Group B crime. Overall, arrests increased by 2.3% (14 arrests).
- Group C (non-criminal) calls for police service increased by 2.9% (224 incidents).
- Year to date reported traffic crashes and traffic citations issued totals are as follows:
 - Property Damage crashes increased 12.4% (73 crashes).
 - Injury crashes increased 12.7% (15 crashes).
 - Fatal crashes did not change; one fatal crash occurred in the first quarter of 2006 and one during this year's first quarter.
 - Hazardous traffic citations issued are up 6.9% (180 citations).
 - Non-hazardous traffic citations issued are down 20.5% (18 citations)
 - License/title/registration citations decreased 5.3% (43 citations).
 - Parking citations decreased 3.2% (8 citations).
- Overall, crimes and non-criminal calls for police service are down 1.0% (95 crimes/calls for service).
