Forty-three years ago today my husband, Jim (James W.) and I were married. It is because of your prompt response on March 16, 2007, that we are able to celebrate our anniversary today.

Jim suffered a stroke shortly after 5:00 P.M. that day. The prompt arrival of a Troy Police unit and EMS was much appreciated. Jim was quickly transported to the Emergency Room at Beaumont, Royal Oak, where he was given tPA.

"If treated, you will have a 30 percent greater chance of having little or no disability after your stroke." This quote comes from the information sheet I was given while we were being informed about tPA. My husband has no disability. He went back to work April 2nd.

I have thanked God many times for the timing of this stroke, (Jim had driven home from Peoria, IL, on the 16th and we literally had the car packed to begin a trip to FL, how awful this could have been had he been driving.) now I want to thank all of the many persons who acted so promptly so that Jim was in a position to receive this miracle drug.

Our quality of life would be entirely different had this situation not been handled so well. Thank you from the bottom of my heart. He is such a wonderful man.
