SUBJECT: Request to Temporarily Waive Parking Restrictions

Background:

- Lori Attan, who resides at 45 Hickory, is requesting the parking restrictions on the South side (non-fire hydrant side) of Hickory street, between Livernois and Plum, be temporary waived on June 24, 2007, between the hours of 1:00 PM and 10:00 PM.
- Ms. Attan is hosting a graduation open house on that date; Hickory is posted no parking on both sides of the street does not have adequate parking for her anticipated guests.
- The Traffic Safety Unit has inspected the location and reports the waiving of the restrictions for the cited time period will not significantly impact emergency response to the area.
- Should the need arise, Ms. Attan will arrange for the immediate removal of any vehicles parked on Hickory.
