- Gabriel Roeder Smith & Company (GRS) – Annual Actuarial Services - Employees Retirement System for the City of Troy for the year ended December 31, 2014..

The System Administrator added the above item to the agenda and provided an engagement letter and a stated fee of \$15,200 for the annual actuarial valuation for the year ended

December 31, 2014. This is a 2.7% increase from the prior year of \$14,800. GRS will use the current assumptions of 6.5% return on investments and use the most current Mortality Table that included Government Entities. This fee does not include additional work required if any under the new Government Accounting Standards Board Statements No. 67 & 68.

- **Prior Government Service Credit**

- Investment Review - Morgan Stanley Performance Report – 4th Qtr. Performance report 2014

Brian Green and Michael Hollycross of Greystone reviewed the consolidated 4th quarter financial results ending December 2014. Items of note included a 2.18% return for the quarter and 5.42% one year and calendar YTD. Mr. Green illustrated the comparison of the recommended “Policy Index” with the City of Troy’s Employee Retirement System Fund Portfolio noting that the portfolio was within the policy guidelines. It was also noted that while still within policy guidelines, Global Equities are over weighted and fixed income is under weighted.

- January 2015 review of Greystone managed assets

Brian Green reviewed performance for the month of January 2015 noting that returns were down 0.76% compared to the S&P down 3% and the NASDAQ Composite down 2.08%. In

addition he suggested a rebalancing between index funds to small caps in the amount of \$3,500,000.

• **UBS Financial Services Presentation**

- Investment Review - City of Troy Employees Retirement Systems Defined Benefit and NAIC - February 2015

Ms. Sorensen of UBS discussed the City of Troy Employee Retirement System, February 2014 "Market Review". Noting that 5% of the index holdings provided 50% of the S&P's return for 2014.

Mr. McBride of UBS has recommended the following changes. Overall he is comfortable with the current holding except for as noted. UBS feels the portfolio is well diversified.

- **Chairman Calice Buy Recommendations**

Chairman Calice shared with the Board the results of his investment research in regards to Cyber Security noting that this segment of the market has significant potential for growth. In particular Palo Alto which is a leader in this industry. In addition he shared his views in the social movement requiring body cameras for police officers. His research indicated that there is significant potential for growth in the storage of data acquired from the use of such technology. In particular the advancements of TASER Corp. in using cloud based storage.

- **System Administrator Darling Request for City General Fund Reimbursement**

- **Request for Financial Information**


