Subject: Standard Purchasing Resolution 4: Award – Macomb County Cooperative Purchasing Agreement – Fleet Vehicles

History

- The six (6) vehicles being purchased are replacement vehicles for the Police Department.
- The six (6) obsolete vehicles will be removed from service and sold at auction with estimated proceeds of \$25,500.00.
- This purchase replaces existing vehicles and does not increase the size of the existing Department of Public Works motor pool fleet.

Purchasing

- Signature Ford Lincoln is the low total bidder in the Macomb County Cooperative Bid. The Macomb County Contract ID numbers 71-15, P.1 b and 71-15 A.9.a.
- The contract pricing is valid thru 2015 model year Ford vehicles.
- On February 10, 2014 City Council authorized departments to utilize sites such as GovDeals.com to dispose of City owned surplus items. (Resolution# 2014-02-017-J-4a) Therefore, note that the City will utilize and market the six (6) obsolete vehicles on GovDeals.com site for optimal trade-in value.
