Subject: Standard Purchasing Resolution 4: National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA) Cooperative Agreement – Kubota Tractor

History

- The Parks Division is responsible for the maintenance of over 900 acres of parkland.
- Maintenance includes using specialized equipment and attachments for renovation, maintenance, and development
- City Council adopted the 2015/16 strategies which includes the development of a Trail and Pathway.
- The Kubota Tractor will allow the Parks Division to efficiently develop and maintain the proposed Trail and Pathway.
- Also note that this tractor will include a snow blower attachment which will be used for snow removal on the trails and pathways once other snow removal priorities have been met.

Purchasing

The National Joint Powers Alliance Cooperative (NJPA) prequalifies vendors through a competitive bid process. Kubota Tractor Corporation of Torrance, CA is one of the awarded low bidders from NJPA. Weingartz of Shelby Township, MI is an authorized vendor from Kubota Tractor Corporation and will be handling the installation of equipment on the tractor and delivery to the City of Troy. All transactions will be completed through Kubota Tractor Corporation.

Funds for this piece of equipment are available in the Capital Budget of the Public Works Departments-General Equipment.
