The committee did not assign additional surveys to be completed.

NEW BUSINESS

A. Request to de-list 2955 Quail Run Drive (Trowbridge House)

The Historic District Study Committee, Historic District Commission and the City Attorney received a letter and attachments from Charlene Harris-Freeman requesting that the resource at 2955 Quail Run be de-listed. The committee discussed the concerns of Charlene Harris-Freeman and Mr. Carl Freeman noted in her letter that include:

- a. They feel that the resource was listed following defective procedures in 1984
- b. They feel that resource does not retain sufficient original materials or features to support historic designation
- c. They feel that because the resource is not part of a larger district with related historic resources, it fails the test of a historic district.

The Committee has asked Allan Motzny to review the procedures followed by the Historic District Commission in 1984 and determine if they complied with state law and the local ordinance at that time. The committee will investigate the architectural significance of the structure and the significance of those who owned the resource. Mr. and Mrs. Freeman were given the checklist that outlines the steps the committee will follow in reviewing their request to de-list.

The Troy Historic Study Committee Meeting was adjourned at 8:30 PM. The next meeting will be held Tuesday, April 4, 2006 at 7:30 p.m. at the Troy Museum & Historic Village.
