

The committee reviewed all the evidence that was collected regarding the historic resource and the procedures followed by the City of Troy at the time of designation.

A memo from (via Mr. and Mrs. Freeman) stated that improper procedures were followed in 1983. A subsequent memo from the City Attorney's office indicated proper procedures were followed in 1983. The committee accepted the City Attorney's findings.

Structural evidence presented by Mr. and Mrs. Harris-Freeman and census records show that the house was constructed after the death of SVR Trowbridge in 1859.

No additional evidence was presented at this meeting regarding the historic significance of any other owner of the resource or of any significant event that occurred in the house.
