

- a. Provide information from the original study report and show where it is deficient. Include data on the relationship of the house (or lack of relationship) with Thomas Gibson
- b. Provide an account of the alterations, an assessment of their significance in terms of the original style and architecture, and when they occurred.
- c. Describe how the Study Committee used defective procedures when establishing the district.

The Millers stated they could verify window replacements were completed in 1985, and that the stated historic significance of the windows was due to improper installation rather than historic use of the windows.

The plat map showing the misidentification of the house site as the Thomas Gibson land can be provided.

The Millers will obtain data from the County Clerk regarding date of construction of the house.




A. Potential Historic Districts
