SUBJECT: Liquor Violation Hearing – Mr. Pizza Bootleg Party Store

On February 20, 2015, the Troy Police Department conducted underage decoy inspections for liquor licensed establishments in the City of Troy. The team went to Mr. Pizza Bootleg Party Store located at 4973 Livernois where an underage minor decoy was sold a six-pack of beer. The person who sold the beer to the minor pled responsible to the charge of *furnishing, sale to person under 21*, and was fined \$100 on March 3, 2015. A copy of the reports documenting the alleged violation is attached to this memo as well as a copy of the licensee's history.

Mr. Pizza Bootleg Party Store has SDD and SDM liquor licenses which means alcohol is sold to patrons for consumption off the premises. Under Michigan law, a local unit of government may request, by resolution, that the MLCC revoke the license of an off-premises licensee if the licensee has sold or furnished alcohol to a minor on at least three separate occasions in a consecutive twelve month period. The licensee is entitled to a due process hearing which provides the licensee an opportunity to challenge the alleged violation. In the due process hearing, the City has the obligation to prove the violation. The liquor violation hearing is scheduled in advance, with notice sent by mail to the licensee.

It should be noted that the licensee failed to appear at the hearing held at Michigan Liquor Control Commission (MLCC) which accepted as true the allegations contained in the report and then imposed a fine of \$800.00. The subject violation is the only one for Mr. Pizza Bootleg Party Store in the calendar year 2015.

Narrative:

Troy # 15-5741 / LCC Violation

On 02/20/2015 at approximately 1750hrs, DPU Officers were conducting LCC checks with minor decoy identified as [REDACTED] identification was confiscated and held for safe keeping by the Troy Police Department.

At approximately 1810hrs, decoy [REDACTED] entered into Mr. Pizza Bootleg Liquor store located at 4973 Livernois in Troy. After entering the store, decoy [REDACTED] retrieved a six pack of Busch light cans and walked to the counter to purchase. The clerk, Amira Shemami, was at the counter and sold the Busch light to decoy [REDACTED] without asking him for identification. At this point Decoy [REDACTED] turned directly to DPU Officers and advised us of the sale.

DPU Officer's made the location and spoke with the clerk Amira Shemami. DPU Officers advised Ms. Shemami of the above listed violation of the Michigan Liquor Control Commission. Ms. Shemami was informed of the violation she committed and was issued citation#15TR01847 for furnishing/sale to a person under 21/fail to inquire of age. Officers retained the sales receipt of \$5.89 for the Busch light and obtained a photograph of the Busch light cans and later turned it over to Troy property as evidence. The purchased items were disposed of. Violation report to be submitted to LCC.

No further action taken.

- (1) Sold or furnished alcoholic liquor to unnamed minor, [REDACTED] date of birth May 5, 1996, who was less than twenty-one (21) years old, contrary to Const 1963, art 4, § 40 and contrary to Section 801(2) and/or Section 701(1) of the Michigan Liquor Control Code, MCL 436.1801(2) and/or MCL 436.1701(1).

FINDINGS OF FACT

At approximately 10:30 a.m., the Administrative Law Judge noted on the record that neither a corporate officer nor an attorney appeared on behalf of the Licensee for a scheduled hearing. A notice of hearing was mailed to the parties, scheduling a hearing for 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 3, 2015, in Sterling Heights, Michigan. Assistant Attorney General Susan Moody-Frezza represented all law enforcement agencies involved in this matter.

The Michigan Liquor Control Commission (Commission) moved for a default of the Licensee under Rule 436.1915(1)(d), which states:

If a proper appearance by a licensee is not made at a scheduled violation hearing in accordance with Rule 436.1913, then the presiding hearing commissioner or duly authorized agent may do any of the following:

- (d) Issue a decision of default.

Further, Section 72(1) of the Administrative Procedures Act of 1969 (APA), 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.272(1), allows a party to a contested case hearing to proceed in the absence of the other party. Section 78(2) of the APA, MCL 24.278(2), allows for the granting of a default against the other party.

Sec. 72(1) of the APA provides in pertinent part:

If a party fails to appear in a contested case after proper service of notice, the agency, if no adjournment is granted, may proceed with the hearing and make its decision in the absence of the party.

Sec. 78(2) of the APA provides, in pertinent part:

Except as otherwise provided by law, disposition may be made of a contested case by stipulation, agreed settlement, consent order, waiver, default or other method agreed upon by the parties.

The Commission's motion for default was granted. As a result of the default, the factual allegations contained in the complaint were deemed proven. The Violation Report and its attachments were admitted into evidence as State's Exhibit 1.

The Administrative Law Judge finds that, while under the direction of law enforcement, Decoy _____ who was eighteen (18) years of age at the time of the incident, entered the above-named licensed establishment on February 20, 2015 and purchased alcoholic liquor from an employee of the Licensee. The Administrative Law Judge further finds that the employee of the Licensee neither demanded nor was shown proper identification showing that the decoy was at least twenty-one (21) years old; however, the employee still sold alcoholic liquor to the decoy. The employee did not make a diligent inquiry to determine the true age of the purchaser.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based upon the above findings of fact, the Administrative Law Judge concludes that the Licensee violated MCL 436.1801(2) as cited in the one charge in the complaint in this matter.


ORDER

In determining penalty, the Administrative Law Judge considered the Licensee's total record, which shows twenty-one (21) previous violations since being licensed on August 16, 1995, at the above-named location under the current ownership.

As a penalty, the Administrative Law Judge Orders a fine of \$800 for the one charge in this matter. Further, the Administrative Law Judge Orders that a suspension of forty (40) continuous days shall be imposed if the fine is not paid, with this suspension to run consecutively and not concurrently with any other suspension Ordered by the Commission, if the fine is not paid within forty-five (45) days from the mailing of this Order.

Further, the Administrative Law Judge Orders the Licensee to pay a total cost of \$7.86 for witness fees involved in connection with the hearing.


