



2014 / 2015 Drug and Alcohol Comparison

In 2015, Troy saw an increase in the number of Drug Offenses committed by persons 18 years of age and younger. In 2014, there were 63 people arrested, ages 18 and under, who committed a total of 103 drug offenses. In 2015, there were a total of 96 people arrested, ages 18 and under, who committed a total of 145 drug offenses. That is a 52.4% increase in the number of people arrested and a 40.8% increase in the number of offenses. More than half of the drug offenses for this age group were for possession, use, or selling of marijuana. One reason for this increase is that there has been a national increase in the number of teenagers who are using marijuana over the past few years. Another reason for this increase could be that our officers are finding more drugs on Troy streets while they are doing FOP (Found on Patrol) patrols. This is the time between emergency Calls for Service that officers get to go out and search for violations and problem areas.

In 2015, Troy saw a decrease in the number of Alcohol Offenses committed by persons 18 years of age and younger. In 2014, there were 48 alcohol offenses committed as compared to 41 alcohol offenses committed in 2015 by person 18 years of age and younger. That is a 14.6% decrease from 2014 to 2015.

In 2015, we saw a decrease in the number of persons, 18 years and younger, who were arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Drugs or Alcohol. In 2014, 5 person under the age of 18 were arrested for driving under the influence as compared to 4 in 2015.
