I have discussed questions advanced by Mayor and Council with Staff, and responses are attached. Thank you for asking questions in advance of the meeting.

Subject: I-04 PROPOSED AGREEMENT WITH THE TROY HISTORICAL SOCIETY FOR OPERATION OF THE TROY HISTORICAL VILLAGE
Questions from Council Member Edna Abraham:

1. What was the rationale for having the option of 5- or 10-year periods for subsequent renewals when this agreement is for 10 years?
2. Who typically serves as the Troy contact person to the THS? (just curious) 3. Does the resolution need to specify a date for the study session? And does staff have a recommendation for when that would be?

Response:

1. The purpose of the 5 or 10 year renewal option is simply to provide more flexibility to the city when the time comes to renew the agreement. If the city is happy with a 10 year renewal, that is an option, if at the time a 5 year renewal is preferred, that is also an option, as well non-renewal of the agreement.
2. Mark Miller, Director of Economic & Community Development is the city contact person for the Historic Society.

We do have a recommended date of September 26, 2016 for the Study Session. A copy of an amended resolution with this date and a location change from the Historic Village to the Council Boardroom will be laid on the table this evening.
