Regular Business:

The Members of the Board welcomed Mr. Mark Owczarzak who was newly appointed to the Board, as an ex-officio member.

Investments:

- Graystone Consulting Presentation

Mr. Robert Alati, Mr. Michael Holycross and Ms. Amy Cole from Graystone Consulting presented the May 2016 Market Outlook & Commentary. Mr. Alati shared additional handouts with the Board and said that he does not see indicators for a “death cross” – a security’s long-term moving average breaking above its short-term moving average. Mr. Holycross said that the data strongly suggests the global manufacturing/industrial recession is ending and recommended the Board

to continue being overweight to U.S. equities. He said he anticipates to see about 7-8% total rate of return for stocks in US equities. Ms. Cole then presented the Total Fund Performance as of 3/31/2016. Graystone Consulting did not recommend any allocation or manager changes within the portfolio at this meeting.

City Manager Brian Kischnick requested a detailed breakdown of Vanguard REIT's investment locations, and Mr. Holycross will provide the information in the next meeting. The Board also discussed a possibility of investing in City of Troy's real estate properties in future.

- UBS Financial Services Presentation

Mr. John Bush, Mr. Antonio Desano and Mr. Darin McBride from UBS Financial Services presented May 2016 Portfolio Review.

Mr. McBride suggested selling all positions in Flower Foods at about \$146,000. He then suggested combining the proceeds with \$426,000 in the ERS account to invest in four companies: Disney, Abbott Labs, AbbVie Inc. and Spectra Energy. A total of \$570,000 would be evenly allocated to the four companies. Mr. McBride also suggested selling GM warrants.
