On behalf of the National Football League, NFL Players Association, and the Detroit Lions, we are pleased to inform you that the NFL Youth Football Fund (YFF) has approved a grant in the amount of \$1,000 to Troy Parks and Recreation for the 2007 NFL Local Agency Grant Program.

National Recreation and Parks Association, a member of the NFL National Youth Football Partners, has chosen your organization to receive a grant from the YFF to recognize outstanding and innovative youth football programs and leagues developed on the local level. Per your grant application proposal, this Local Agency Grant will be distributed to your chapter in order to help support your youth football program.

By accepting this YFF contribution, you also are accepting the following terms and conditions of this Grant as set forth in this agreement:

- All Local Agency Grant funds must be used solely for the purpose of carrying out the Program as described in the grant application. Any grant funds which are not used for the Local Agency Grant Program on or before December 31, 2007 must be returned to the YFF.
- NFL logos (including but not limited to the NFL Youth Football Fund, NFL Youth Football Partners, NFL shield, NFLPA and NFL team logos) may not be used without prior written approval from the NFL. All usage requests should be submitted to my attention and cannot be implemented without the receipt of written approval.
- Local Agency Grant funds may not be used for any purpose that is not exclusively charitable or educational. For example, Local Agency Grant Funds may not be used to pay for participant entry into any non-charitable youth football programs (e.g., NFL FLAG) since such actions would present a conflict of interest for the YFF, which is a 501(c)(3), non-profit foundation.
- All Local Agency Grant recipients agree to hold the Grant funds in an account dedicated exclusively to permissible non-profit purposes and shall further be shown separately on their books for easy reference. Additionally, all Local Agency Grant recipients may be subject to financial review and, therefore, must retain copies of all receipts and reports with respect to the Grant for at least four years following completion of the grant. Local Agency Grant recipients' books and records shall be made available for inspection by the Directors of the YFF, at reasonable times.
