Legal Considerations

Policy Considerations

- The vehicles are used on a daily basis to assure proper and proactive Police protection and service (Goals I & V).
- The purchase of the Police and Public Works vehicles would assure the safety and welfare of citizens and businesses and also reduce the liability for the City. (Goal I).

Options

City management and the Public Works Fleet Division recommend awarding contracts to provide fourteen (14) 2008 vehicles for the Police and Public Works departments from Buff Whelan Chevrolet of Sterling Heights, MI, and three (3) 2008 vehicles for the Police department from Red Holman Pontiac GMC of Westland, MI, through Oakland County Cooperative Purchasing Agreements at an estimated total cost of \$251,700.00 and \$63,855.00 respectively.
