Writer, Officer Morgan, and Student Enforcement Aide went to Troy Party Store located at 6990 John R to conduct a L.C.C. inspection. had no identification with him, it was being held at the Police Department. He activated a small personal tape recorder and gave a brief introduction indicating time, date and location. He then entered the business, selected a 6 pack of Mike's Cranberry Lemonade and proceeded to the cash register. presented the 6 pack to sales clerk Daniel Rydzewski for purchase. Rydzewski never asked for any identification, and then rang up the sale. gave Rydzewski a \$20 bill to pay for the Lemonade. returned to our location and handed the 6 pack of Mik'e Hard Lemonade over to Sgt. Schaufler and I. A short time later Sgt. Schaufler and I entered the store and made contact with store owner Daniel Rydzewski. We explained the situation and issued a citation to him for "Fail to Inquire as to Age." (citation #710332) Rydzewski acknowledged selling to the Student Enforcement Aide and further advised officers that he was really busy. We gathered the required information to complete an L.C.C. violation report and advised Daniel what would be required by him. The 6 pack and cassette tape were taken to TPD and processed as evidence. (tag #142230)

- (1) Sold or furnished alcoholic liquor to minor
who was less than twenty-one (21) years old, contrary to Const 1963, art 4,
§ 40 and contrary to Section 801(2) and/or Section 701(1) of the Michigan Liquor
Control Code, MCL 436.1801(2) and/or MCL 436.1701(1).

FINDINGS OF FACT

Daniel Rydzewski, President of the above named Licensed Corporation, appeared before this Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) and after being advised of his constitutional right to be represented by an attorney pursuant to Rule 436.1909(2), as promulgated in the Michigan Administrative Code, waived right to legal counsel and entered a plea of acknowledgment to the one charge as stated in Case No. 7-118072 pursuant to Section 903 of the Michigan Liquor Control Code, MCL 436.1903, and Rule 436.1909(1) of the Michigan Liquor Control Commission (MLCC).

The ALJ accepted said plea of acknowledgment after being assured it was entered voluntarily and with the full understanding of its meaning and implications.

On Motion of Rosendo Asevedo, Assistant Attorney General who represented all law enforcement in this matter, the ALJ entered the Violation Report of this case and attachments thereto into the record as evidence without objection.

The ALJ believes and finds as fact, on the basis of the Violation Report, that one [redacted] while under the direction of the Troy Police Department, entered the above named licensed establishment on August 23, 2007, and purchased alcoholic liquor from the President of the above named Licensed Corporation without showing proper proof of age.

The ALJ further believes and finds as fact, on the basis of his statements, that said [redacted] was 18 years of age at the time of the incident. The ALJ further concluded from his appearance at the hearing that said [redacted] looked his true age of 18; the ALJ also concluded that a prudent person would not mistake said [redacted] of being of legal drinking age without making a further diligent inquiry.

The ALJ further finds that the President of the Licensed Corporation in this case neither demanded, nor was shown proper proof of age and did not make a diligent inquiry to determine the proper true age of the purchaser.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based upon the aforementioned Plea and Findings of Fact, the ALJ concludes that the Licensed Corporation in Case No. 7-118072, did violate Section 801(2) of the Michigan Liquor Control Code, MCL 436.1801(2), as cited in the one charge of the Complaint in this matter.

ORDER


In determining penalty for the charge for which a violation was found, the ALJ considered the Licensed Corporation's total record, which shows three previous violations, all similar to the charge in this complaint, with the most recent violation occurred on October 27, 2003, since being licensed on November 23, 1983 at the above location under the current ownership.

Further, in determining penalty for the charge for which a violation was found, the ALJ considered that the Licensed Corporation purchased an "age and ID verifier" machine on October 30, 2007 as a result of this incident. See Exhibit #1

The ALJ, therefore, Orders a fine of \$500 as penalty in this matter. The ALJ further Orders that a suspension of 25 continuous days be imposed if the fine is not paid with this suspension, if served, to run consecutively and not concurrently with any other suspension Ordered by the Michigan Liquor Control Commission for this Licensed Corporation.

In addition, the ALJ Orders the Licensed Corporation to pay total cost of \$8.70 for witness fees involved in connection with the hearing.
