SUBJECT: Standard Purchasing Resolution 4: Award – Oakland County Cooperative Purchasing Agreement – Fleet Vehicles

## Background

- Motor City Harley-Davidson is the low total bidder in the Oakland County cooperative bid.
- The four motorcycles being purchased are replacements, due to lease termination.

## Financial Considerations

- Funds are available in the Public Works Fleet Division capital account # 565.7981.
- Motorcycle usage will be charged back to the Police Department on an hourly rate basis, consistent with current vehicle rental practice.

## Policy Considerations

- The motorcycles are used on a daily basis, weather permitting, to assure proper and proactive Police protection and service (Goal I).
- The purchase of the Police motorcycles would assure the safety and welfare of citizens and businesses and also reduce the liability for the City. (Goal I).
- Harley Davidson motorcycles are fuel efficient and maneuver more easily thru congested traffic than patrol cars. (Goal II)

## Options

- City management and the Public Works Fleet Division recommend awarding a contract to purchase four (4) 2008 FLHTP Harley Davidson motorcycles from Motor City Harley Davidson, Farmington Hills, MI, through the Oakland County purchasing agreement at an estimated total cost of \$61,744.00.
