Hammond continues to work on the listing of gas stations that offer assistance to persons with disabilities in pumping their fuel.

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Done and Hammond attended the Senior Expo. They reported a good turnout and felt it was a success.

Cindy Stewart offered to do the commendation letters from this Committee during Buchanan's absence.

Done will not be attending the May meeting due to her training for Leader Dog for the Blind ownership.

ITEM VIII – REPORTS

Lin reported on suggestions he submitted to City Council for the addition to the Troy Public Library as well as changes to the City Master Plan.

Chong reported that the elevator in his High School is not always available for a student that uses a wheelchair. He will look into having a reminder given to other students during announcements or student news that the elevator should be kept available for the use of persons with disabilities. Chong was also advised to contact Wright & Filippis and Binsons to inquire about assistance with a stairway lift chair.

ITEM IX – MEMBER COMMENT

Done reports that April is Autism Awareness Month. HBO is showing a film called "Autism – The Musical" and there is also a book currently out called "Normal People Scare Me".

Stewart reported that he continues his involvement with the Friendship Club and activities for special needs youth. Volunteers are always needed; anyone interested should see him.

Stewart reports that a grant from Kellogg for a boundless playground was not awarded to Troy Parks and Recreation. He will find out how soon it can be applied for again.

Stewart reported that there is minimal progress in the development of the walking/biking trails.

Kempen would like to see the plans for the Library and is happy with the progress made by this Committee so far.

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Clark reported that her employer, J.A. Ditty and Associates will be having a workshop May 9th regarding auto insurance coverages and services. Representatives from Social Security will also be there to give information regarding interviews for disability claimants.
