SUBJECT: Announcement of Public Hearing – Liquor Violations

History:

- Twelve establishments had liquor violations in 2012. City Council may decide to hold Public Hearings to address these violations. City Council could then decide if the liquor license for each establishment should be recommended for renewal by the Michigan Liquor Control Commission. All twelve violations can be combined into one meeting that is already scheduled for February 20, 2013, as part of the annual schedule of City Council Regular Meetings.
- Violations occurred at the following establishments:

 - Thunderbird Lanes – 400 W. Maple 48084
 - Nordstrom Café – 2850 W. Big Beaver 48084
 - Buscemi's – 3176 Rochester 48083
 - Mon Jin Lau – 1515 E. Maple 48083
 - Troy Party Store – 6990 John R. 48085
 - Hamlin Pub – 3946 Rochester 48083
 - El Patio Mexican Restaurant – 2891 E. Big Beaver 48083
 - Camp Ticonderoga – 5725 Rochester 48085
 - National Coney Island – 3364 Rochester 48083
 - Mayur Indian Cuisine – 5113 Rochester 48085
 - Palms/Simbad's – 336 John R. 48083

Financial Considerations:

- There are no financial considerations.

Legal Considerations:

- The City ordinance provides for hearings for those licensed establishments that violate liquor laws.

Options:

- City Council may hold Public Hearings for the establishments that had violations in 2012.
- City Council may direct City Administration to address the violations administratively.
