Subject: Sale of Equipment - Surplus Police Vehicle

History

In the past, Troy City Council granted approval to dispose of surplus vehicles either by live or online auctions with the disposal fee rolled into the sale price, which is commonly referred to as a Buyer's Premium. The intent is to receive fair market value for the equipment the City sells.

Macomb Community College has expressed an interest in making an outright purchase for one (1) used, Ford Crown Victoria, four door, police package, model year 2007 or newer, patrol car. It would be utilized on their driving course to provide Emergency Vehicle Operations (EVO) training for Macomb Police Academy cadets and in-service police officers. The Troy Police Department utilizes the Macomb Police Academy for basic police academy training and sends in-service officers to Macomb Community College basic EVO refresher courses.

The Motor Pool Division of the Public Works Department has an out of service, 2009 Ford Crown Victoria with 90,000 miles ready for disposal. The vehicle has been stripped of all emergency and police equipment.

Purchasing

In July 2012, the City sold the exact same vehicle (make and model), model year 2008 at auction for \$5,200.00. The fair market value (FMV) of the 2009, Ford Crown Victoria patrol car has been established at \$6,200.00.

Financial

Proceeds from the sale are deposited to the revenue account - Gains on sale -capital assets and used for future equipment purchases.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the 2009 Ford Crown Victoria be sold to the Macomb Community College for the fair market value of \$6,200.00 for the purpose of providing Emergency Vehicle Operations (EVO) training for Macomb Police Academy cadets and in-service police officers.
