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**Tabled Items**

Sergeant Cantlon had the following update for the Committee on the application by M & M Troy, Inc., which is the Clark Gas Station located at John R and Maple Roads.

A building site inspection was performed by Mark Stimac of the Building Department, Chuck Riesterer of the Fire Department, and Sergeant Cantlon in an attempt to determine if the gas station would be able to support that level of stock. The applicant has been advised to send a formal drawing of the building with square footage, the location of the proposed stock, and the value of the stock. A response has not been received.

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### **Informational Items**

City Attorney Lori Grigg Bluhm spoke to the Committee and presented each member with a "Liquor Advisory Committee Reference Book". Ms. Bluhm briefly explained the contents of the book. The Open Meetings Act and Freedom of Information Act sections of the Reference Book were explained in more detail.

Concerning the matter of absence from a meeting, it was decided by the Committee that a member must make notification of inability to attend a meeting, but a reason for the absence will not be required.

Ms. Bluhm spoke in depth to the Committee regarding Chapter 101 of the Troy City Ordinance. She explained that the revisions suggested at the July 14, 2008 Liquor Advisory Committee Meeting were presented to City Council on July 21, 2008 as an informational item. Revisions were presented to City Council on August 11, 2008 as an action item. Chapter 101 was adopted at that time.

Inasmuch as there were limited time constraints which did not allow the final revisions to be reviewed by the Liquor Advisory Committee, the members have decided that Chapter 101 will be re-addressed at the November 10, 2008 meeting.
