WHEREAS the township residents overwhelmingly approved the proposal to incorporate and elected a Charter Commission on June 7, 1955;


WHEREAS Troy has become a stable and viable community in which to work, live and play;


WHEREAS the Troy Chamber of Commerce will continue to partner with city and community leaders to support a high quality business environment, strong educational system, and the work of the non-profit community.
