Livingston has administrative responsibilities for the Directed Patrol Unit, Evidence Technicians and Traffic Safety Unit. Police Officers assigned to the Traffic Safety Unit recommended **Lieutenant Livingston** for this award; and

**WHEREAS,** In an effort to reduce costs and improve efficiency, the Police Department is committed to the transition from paper reports to reports in electronic format. During 2009, **Lieutenant Livingston** was instrumental in teaching Police Department employees how to use Oakland County CLEMIS (Courts and Law Enforcement Management Information System) electronic Citations and Crash reporting programs; and

**WHEREAS, Lieutenant Livingston** established Police Department policy on the forfeiture of vehicles from persons arrested for second and third offenses of Operating While Intoxicated. He also made significant contributions toward the City's Cost Recovery Ordinance. He is working on Distracted Driver and Motor Carrier Enforcement Ordinances with the City Attorney's Office; and

**WHEREAS, Lieutenant Livingston** contributes a significant amount of his own time on work related projects in an effort to achieve Police Department goals and provide quality service to the community. He is respected by his peers, the employees that work for him, and many of the countless members of the community he serves;
