SUBJECT: Proof of TIPS/TAMS Server Training

- During the Troy City Council Hearings scheduled March 1, 2010 and March 15, 2010 the following establishments were given notice to appear for a series of public hearings regarding alleged violations of **SALES TO MINOR (DPU)** (Compliance Test) and for one establishment for **Allowing Fight on License Premises** and **Allowing Persons (other than employee) After Hours**:
 - Marriott International, Inc. / WHP Hotel LLC (dba: Troy Marriott) 200 West Big Beaver Road (*date of violation May 7, 2009*)
 - Charles Edward Post 14, The American Legion 1340 West Maple Road (*date of violation May 7, 2009*)
 - Joseph Koolisky's LLC (dba: Joe Kool's) 1835 East Big Beaver Road (*date of violation May 7, 2009*)
 - San Marino Club, Inc. (dba: San Marino Catering Hall / Tre Monti Restaurant) 1685 East Big Beaver Road (*date of violation May 7, 2009*)
 - Mar-Bill Inc. (dba: Parrott Cove Yacht Club) 33475 Dequindre (*date of violations May 7, 2009 and October 28, 2009*)
 - McCormick and Schmick Restaurant Corp. (dba McCormick and Schmick Seafood Restaurant) 2850 Coolidge Highway (*date of violation October 28, 2009*)
 - Kruse and Muer Troy, LLC (dba: Kruse and Muer on Wilshire) 911 Wilshire Road (*date of violation December 17, 2009*)
 - MEI Holdings, LLC / Troy Hotel Property LLC (dba: Hilton Homewood Suites) 1495 Equity West (*date of violation October 28, 2009*)
 - Yara, Inc. (dba: Lebanese Grill) 1600 Rochester Road (*date of violations March 22, 2009*)
- The City Council of Troy, after due notice, **RECOMMENDED** to the Michigan Liquor Control Commission that the nine above establishments in the City of Troy, have their appropriate liquor licenses **BE RENEWED** with the **STIPULATION** that all employees be TIPS or TAMS trained and that the Licensees provide proof of training to the Troy Police Department within ninety (90) days.
- All nine establishments provided the Troy Police Department with proof of TIPS or TAMS training within the required 90 days.
