Subject: Request to temporarily waive the parking restriction on Grand Haven

### Background

920 on The Park is a residential high rise located at 920 John R. It is managed by the Preservation Housing Management group. They will be resurfacing their parking lot starting on OCT 4<sup>th</sup> 2010 and it should take approximately 10 days for the resurfacing and curing of the new parking lot.

They request that the parking restriction on the south side of Grand Haven from the west driveway of the American House located at 2300 Grand Haven to the west Driveway of 920 John R be waived during this resurfacing project. The north side will remain no parking. Currently parking on Grand Haven on both the north and south side of the street is prohibited.

Such requests have been granted in the past and no problems have been reported.



### Recommendation

SGT Harden from the PD and FSA Arnold from the FD reviewed the request and inspected the area and found that granting this request will not impede emergency vehicles or prevent access to fire hydrants the area. The Chief of Police and The Chief of Fire Services approve this request.



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### City Attorney's Review as to Form and Legality

City Ordinance under Traffic Control Order 81-1-P prohibits parking on Grand Haven on both the north and south side of the street. City council action is required to grant a variance.
