Earlier this year, the Community Affairs Department obtained approval from the City Manager to purchase flags displaying the City's celebratory 50th Anniversary logo.

As part of the 50th Anniversary celebration, we are flying the 50th anniversary flag under the City flag on the flagpoles for the remainder of 2005 at City buildings including City Hall, the Community Center, and the Police Department. At the end of 2005, the City will retire the anniversary flag.

Option for Fire Stations:

The Fire stations and the Fire-Police Training Center were never supplied with City flags. However, we do have 50th Anniversary flags for them. There is room to fly them under the American flags. When the anniversary flags are retired, we will purchase official City flags to fly at the Fire Stations.
