Subject: Federal Funding for Major Road Work  
14 Mile, John R to Dequindre

## History:

At the Oakland County Federal Aid Funding Committee meeting of February 12, 2019, \$1,200,000 in federal funds were awarded for improvements (mill and heavy overlay) on 14 Mile Road, from Edward (east of John R) to Dequindre in 2022. The total project cost is estimated at \$1,500,000.

14 Mile Road is under the jurisdiction of the RCOC and is a border road between Troy and Madison Heights, so the local match will be shared by Troy, Madison Heights and RCOC. Troy and Madison Heights share of the project is estimated at \$75,000/each. RCOC's share of the project is estimated at \$150,000 (not including design and construction engineering services).

RCOC has agreed to provide the preliminary engineering (design) and construction engineering (inspection and testing) services for the project at no cost to Troy or Madison Heights. The estimated cost of these services is \$375,000. A future cost participation agreement will be presented to City Council for approval once a contract with MDOT has been executed by the RCOC as the lead agency.

The award of \$1,200,000 in federal funds in 2022 brings the total federal funds approved for use on major roads in Troy for 2019-2022 to a total of just under \$33,000,000. Troy's match to these federal funds is approximately \$9,000,000. Projects included in this total are:

- 2019 – John R, Long Lake to South Blvd – Construction
- 2020 – Rochester, Barclay to Trinway – Right-of –Way
- 2021 – Adams, Long Lake to Square Lake – Construction
- 2022 – Rochester, Barclay to Trinway – Construction
- 2022 – 14 Mile, John R to Dequindre – Construction
