Subject: Public Hearing for May 20, 2019 to Reprogram Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) PY 2018 Funds

---

### Background

The City of Troy is required by the Oakland County Division of Community & Home Improvement to advertise and conduct a Public Hearing for the Reprogramming of CDBG funds. The Clearance & Demo account for CDBG program year 2018 has a balance of \$105,082 because this project cannot be completed per Oakland County. The balance of funds from Program Year 2018 must be expended or relinquished.

We need the extra funds leftover in the PY 2018 account to complete the project at the Troy Farm, part of the City of Troy's 900 acres of preserved park land. Located on the corner of Beach Road and South Boulevard the Troy Farm is home to one of Troy's original barns. The City of Troy would like to preserve this historical landmark in the City and would replace the roofing and any associated structural repairs. The balance of the PY 2018 funds will supplement additional funds already allocated for this project.

### Recommendation

It is recommended that after the conclusion of the Public Hearing on Monday, February 25, 2019, Troy City Council approve the reprogramming of Program Year 2018 funds in the amount of \$105,082 from the Clearance & Demo account to the Non-Residential Historic Preservation account to complete the roofing project at the Troy Farm's barn.
