**PARTICIPATION:** Any interested person may attend and participate. The hearing site is accessible, including handicapped parking. The Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) will hold a pre-hearing to consider DTE Electric Company's (DTE Electric) June 25, 2019 application requesting approval of: 1) DTE Electric's amended Renewable Energy plan; 2) Transfer Prices for DTE Electric Renewable Energy Contracts and Company-owned Renewable Energy Systems; and 3) \$20,809 Energy Waste Reduction Credits to be transferred at zero cost from the DTE Electric's Energy Optimization Plan to, and used for compliance with its amended Renewable Energy plan. DTE Electric is not requesting any modification of the current Renewable Energy plan surcharge of \$0.00/meter for all customer classes.

All documents filed in this case shall be submitted electronically through the Commission's E-Dockets website at: [michigan.gov/mpscedockets](http://michigan.gov/mpscedockets). Any person wishing to intervene and become a party to the case shall electronically file a petition to intervene with this Commission by September 5, 2019. (Interested persons may elect to file using the traditional paper format.) The proof of service shall indicate service upon DTE Energy Company's attorney, David S. Maquera, One Energy Plaza, Detroit, MI 48226.

Any person wishing to appear at the hearing to make a statement of position without becoming a party to the case may participate by filing an appearance. To file an appearance, the individual must attend the hearing and advise the presiding administrative law judge of his or her wish to make a statement of position. All information submitted to the Commission in this matter becomes public information, thus available on the Michigan Public Service Commission's website, and subject to disclosure. Please do not include information you wish to remain private.
